### HOW TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT:

- **Send an email with the names and dates-of-birth of those registering for a vaccination to [STCcovidvaccineclinic@towerhealth.org](mailto:STCcovidvaccineclinic@towerhealth.org), or call 215-291-7135.**
- Include a telephone number and an email address, so we can contact you with the date and time of your appointment.

### WHAT YOU NEED TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Your driver's license (of parent/legal guardian) or other form of photo identification
- Your insurance card

There is no out-of-pocket cost for you to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. However, please bring your health insurance card with you to your vaccine appointment. Tower Health will bill your insurer for an administration fee for both vaccine doses. You will not be responsible for vaccination charges not covered by your insurance. If you do not have insurance, we will not charge you an administration fee.

### WHAT TO KNOW BEFORE YOUR APPOINTMENT:

It is vital that you know and follow the steps and information below:

- Individuals under 18 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.
- Please do not arrive late.
- Please do not arrive more than 15 minutes early to avoid disrupting other scheduled appointments.
- The entire appointment should last 30-45 minutes, including a mandatory 15-minute observation period.
- Successful vaccination of the Pfizer vaccine requires two doses. Your follow-up shot will be scheduled when you receive your first shot.
- Even after vaccination, you should continue to wear a mask in public, avoid large crowds if possible, and wash your hands frequently.
