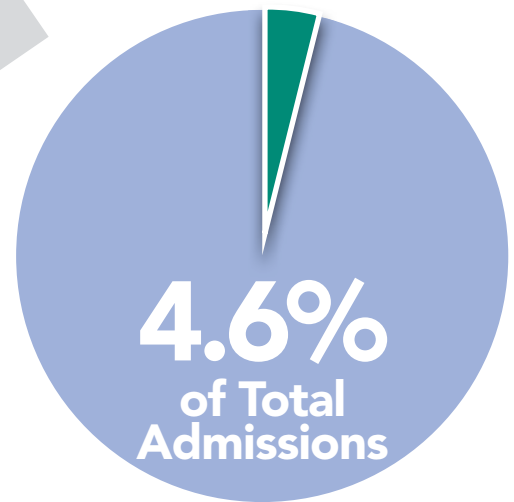

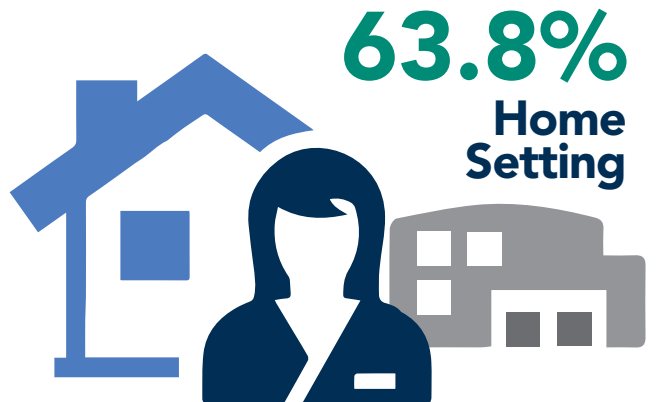

Average Treatment Time

All patient programs are individually developed based on each patient's unique needs. Program schedules may vary from patient to patient dependent upon diagnosis, estimated length of stay, activity tolerance, previous functional level, and functional goals. The discipline is based on your individual needs. There are some services, such as speech therapy or psychological services, that you may not need. Your physician, case manager, and therapists will discuss your individualized plan of care with you. Patients must be able to participate in three or more hours of therapy each day for at least five days per week.

- Physical Therapy
- Occupational Therapy

- Speech Therapy
- Psychological Services
