Asking Questions, Inspiring Excellence

Problem-solver Sergei Szortyka and his sister P. Nancy Deale have built a business and a life philosophy on the guiding principle of making things better. And from Pediatrics to Street Medicine to the new Heart Catheterization Lab, Sergei, his wife, Linda, and his Reading-based company, Quaker Maid Meats, have contributed significantly to making Reading Hospital the best it can be.

"All areas of Reading Hospital are important to me," explains Sergei. When he sees a need, he acts on it, asking what resources will lead to improvement. A champion of all facets of the Reading Hospital mission, Sergei offers the vision and resources essential to the continuance of excellence and the pursuit of new initiatives.

When Dr. Herman Lawson, current Chief of the Division of Neurologic Surgery, operated on Linda, likely saving her life, the couple decided to show their appreciation with a Grateful Patient gift. With this donation, Dr. Lawson was able to pursue ground-breaking research at Johns Hopkins University on Parkinson's disease.

The Szortykas' focus and that of their company is always on the greater community, with Sergei asking, "How can we help?" This spirit of creating local opportunities led the Szortykas and Quaker Maid Meats to not only originate the idea of a high school senior internship program but also to provide the financial support to start it. Now part of the Pathways Program, the internship initiative pairs local

high school seniors with mentor professionals at Reading Hospital.

In its eleventh year, the High School Internship Program is the 2024 recipient of the statewide Workplace Innovators Award from The Hospital and Healthsystem Association of Pennsylvania and has hosted nearly 120 students, all of whom have pursued a college education. Seventeen students are now Reading Hospital employees, and 33 students are associates of the hospital, working as community health advisors and for the Street Medicine program. The High School Internship Program now welcomes qualified seniors from all Berks County high schools for internships and healthcare-career job shadowing,

and Pathways offers college internships as well as community-based learning and employment opportunities. And it all started with Sergei asking the question: What can we do to help local youth?

A frequent speaker at the High School Internship Program's end-of-year celebration, Sergei shares a message with the students that resonates with us all: *Every one of us has something to give, and we are stakeholders in this community institution called Reading Hospital. Keep moving forward and paying it forward. Keep asking questions, seeking answers—and always find ways to give back.*

Always Giving Back

Supporting Reading Hospital’s New Cardiac Catheterization Lab

When Sandy Young lost her husband of 26 years, she was determined to find a way to turn her loss into a powerful way of doing good. “I don’t want another family to go through what we went through,” she explains, referring to her husband’s passing following double bypass surgery three years ago.

Sandy’s experience enabled her to see a need for the newest and most advanced cardiac care—and that the community could benefit enormously from a new Cath Lab at Reading Hospital.

A Cardiac Catheterization Lab, or Cath Lab, is a place where cardiologists perform both tests and procedures to treat cardiovascular disease, a condition becoming increasingly prevalent in our community. In fact, heart disease is the leading cause of death in the United States.

Facilitating significant change in supporting the Cath Lab was just the beginning for Sandy, who continues her support through volunteer work for the Street Medicine Program, serving on Reading Hospital Foundation’s Development Committee, and supporting many other local community initiatives.

A Legacy of Support for Education

Chair Emeritus of Obstetrics and Gynecology at Reading Hospital Peter Schwartz, MD has served Reading Hospital and his community as a leader not only in his discipline but also in medical ethics and residency education. “We want to be at the forefront of developing new services with innovative opportunities in healthcare,” says Dr. Schwartz.

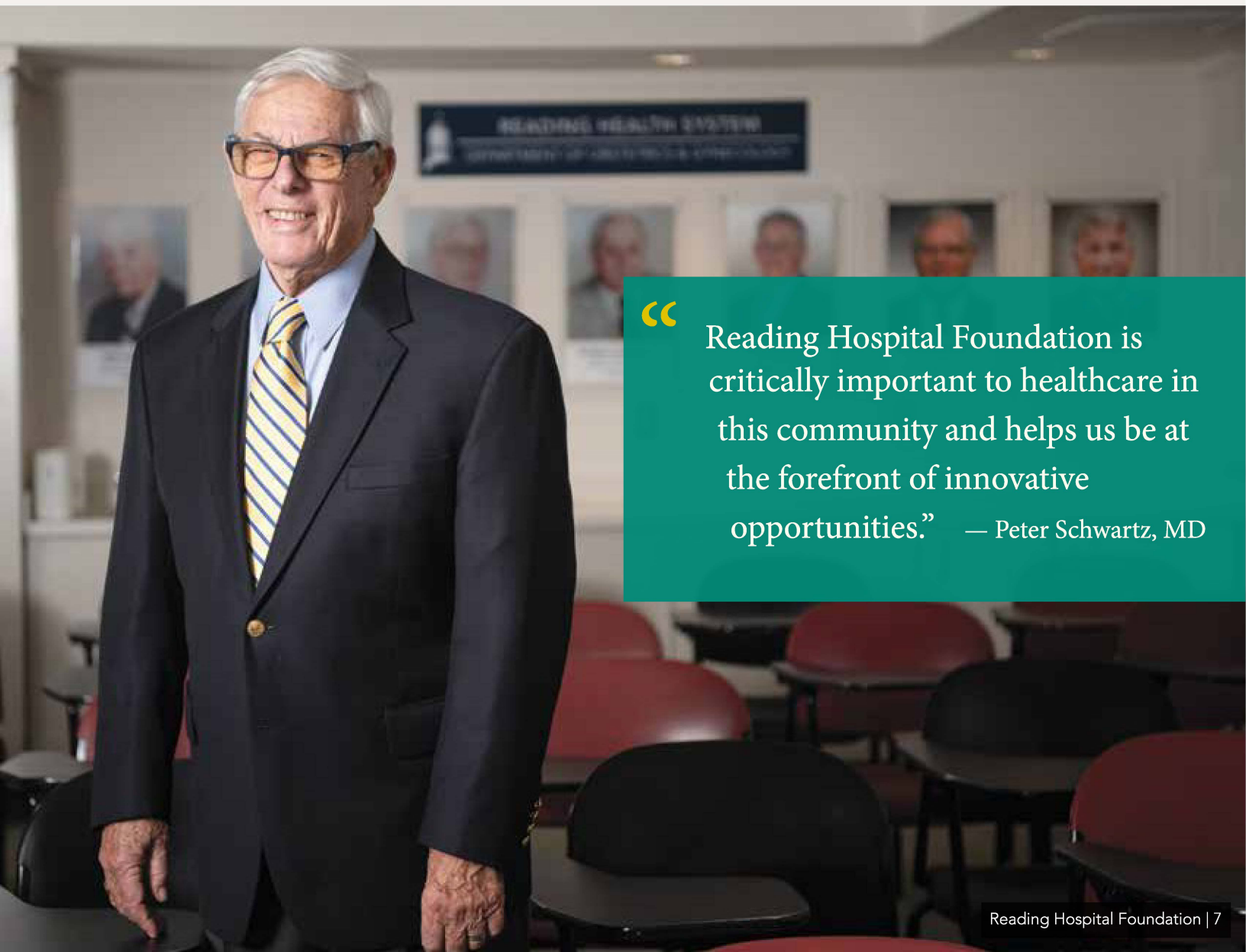
Endowed by Dr. Schwartz and his wife, The Peter A. Schwartz, MD Obstetrics and Gynecology Education Fund supports lectures, ongoing professional development, and information on the latest technological developments for the OB/GYN department. “Our educational program is key to the healthcare of women in our community,” explains Dr. Schwartz.

Dr. Schwartz also worked with the Reading Hospital Medical Humanities Curriculum Committee to integrate the arts, music, and other disciplines into physicians’ ongoing course

work to update the early 20th century apprenticeship model of training for medical doctors. In addition to incorporating new areas of study and providing opportunities for self expression, Dr. Schwartz and the Committee also updated outmoded forms of pedagogy and added a focus on connecting with patients. The twofold purpose of this innovative educational model is not only to reduce physician burnout but also to enhance patient care. “To me, the joy of being a physician is not just the cure, but that we are able to make people feel better when we are more caring,” says Dr. Schwartz.

Dr. Schwartz’s dedication to education extends to Ethiopia where he has not only helped create the first code of medical ethics but has also started a foundation with his wife to help students further their studies.

“Giving back,” says Dr. Schwartz, “gives us tremendous joy.”

EDUCATION

Nursing Simulation Improves Support Care Education

The latest in training technology is helping educate nurses in both pediatric and adult life support care settings. A pediatric manikin provides real-time feedback during Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS) classes and

interdisciplinary simulations. iPads allow for direct control and operation via a pediatric manikin app. Adult manikins used with shock links assist with medical-surgical nursing and other classes and simulations. Recording simulations and trainings with webcams and microphones help identify improvement opportunities.



CARING FOR OUR COMMUNITY

Portraits of Hope

To honor founding core Street Medicine physicians, Dr. Larry Rotenberg commissioned artist Elaine Housman to create portraits of Dr. Andy Donato, Dr. Sarah Luber, and Dr. Eugene York for display in the Department of Medicine.



The Street Medicine team of three employees and five volunteer physicians continues to reach additional sheltered, unsheltered, and at-risk members of the community with primary, preventive, and specialty care. Fiscal Year 2024 saw a nearly 75% increase in patient encounters over the previous year, and diagnoses increased by 28%.

The Street Medicine team is changing lives by bringing care, treatment, and hope to struggling community members. One story of a life transformed is that of 41-year-old Jordan. Struggling with poverty, homelessness, and substance abuse disorder for most of life left Jordan feeling overwhelmed and vulnerable. His medical history of asthma, COPD, diabetes, and heart disease was complicated by his intermittent homelessness and addiction to crack cocaine. Interventions by the Street Medicine team helped Jordan address each of these challenges. Having successfully completed rehabilitation, Jordan now enjoys a drug-free lifestyle. His medical issues have also been addressed because of the healthcare he has received, and he is now medically stable. And, thanks to the Street Medicine Team, Jordan is no longer without a home.

HELPING PATIENTS

Promoting Innovation, Education, and Research

Reading Hospital Foundation continues to seek out innovative ways to help patients.

- Dental Assistance Grants provide much-needed dental work for patients whose mouth, gums, and teeth suffer following cancer treatments
- A partnership with the nonprofit Unite for Her provides complementary and wellness therapies for patients undergoing breast cancer treatment
- Robes for Radiation, a program inspired by patient Andi Fishlock in 2021, continues to supply patients with robes
- Newly diagnosed McGlinn Cancer Institute patients receive Comfort Bags at their initial appointments
- Reading Hospital Foundation and The Friends of Reading Hospital partnered to build the C1 Courtyard Project, creating a place of peace and healing for patients undergoing cancer treatment
- Mammography Coach continue to bring diagnostic care to underserved women of Berks County and surrounding areas, and the Patient Financial Assistance Program works to enroll under- or uninsured women
- Reading Hospital physician Dr. Thomas Geng generously donated memorial funds following the passing of his wife, Shelly, who had received treatment at the Reading Hospital McGlinn Infusion Center. The funds were used to renovate a nurses' lounge

Grants Enhance Patient Care, Staff Education, and Community Involvement

Life Saving Blood Warmers

Providing warm blood to trauma patients improves survival rates. Buddy Lite Blood Warmers allow TowerDIRECT and EMS to provide warm blood, saving lives during critical care support.

English and Spanish Language Classes for Staff Members

Better workplace communication and job mobility start with improved language skills. Up to 200 Reading Hospital staff members with limited proficiency in English or Spanish will take free courses through Reading Area Community College and the Literary Council of Reading.

Summer Internship Training Provides Learning Opportunities

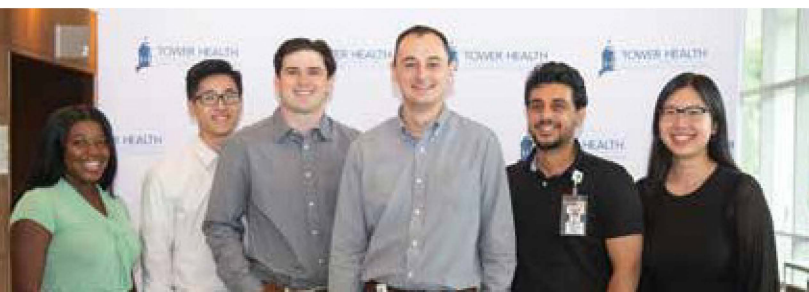
A six-week summer program for undergraduates and a program for first- and second-year medical students allows for supervised, guided research and clinical observation experiences at Reading Hospital. In addition, students can attend seminars and complete a formal research presentation to faculty upon finishing their internship.

Workplace Training Promotes Teamwork, Improves Morale

The Healthy Workforce Academy provided training to 37 Unit and Senior Directors, impacting a total of more than 1,000 Reading Hospital employees. Through education and coaching, staff learned skills to promote healthy and safe workplace interaction, increasing employee engagement and job satisfaction and reducing turnover.

Chief Resident Leadership Program Enhances Skill Development

Supporting post-graduate education and professional development of our medical residents is the goal of the Chief Resident Leadership Program. A comprehensive curriculum supports career development, enhances communication abilities, and promotes team leadership skills.



CARDIAC CATHETERIZATION LAB

New Cardiac Catheterization Lab at Reading Hospital

Life-Saving Diagnosis and Treatment Close to Home

State-of-the-art equipment, fast response time, and superior clinicians are saving lives at Reading Hospital's new Cath Lab. The need for the latest imaging technology and staff to diagnose and treat cardiovascular events more quickly and efficiently was clear, and Reading Hospital Foundation responded by meeting a \$2.1 million fundraising goal to construct a new Cath Lab.

The number of patients in need of heart and vascular care is increasing, and the Cath Lab allows cardiologists to use minimally invasive tests and procedures to treat these patients. More than 2,500 procedures, such as treating blocked arteries, stent therapy, and angioplasty, are performed each year with great efficiency. In fact, the new Cath Lab has some impressive statistics:

- 75 minutes: median time between EMS contact and opening of blocked vessel
- 54 minutes: median time between patient arrival and opening of blocked vessel

Successfully diagnosing and treating heart blockages requires the superior imaging that allows clinicians to see blockages clearly and open them using wires, balloons, and stents. The new Cath Lab's technology provides the high quality imaging needed for even delicate procedures, such as mitral clip and device implantations.

The best in technology and equipment attracts the best in cardiologists and clinicians, creating a win-win pairing resulting in more positive patient outcomes. Additionally, the new Cath Lab uses nearly 50% less radiation, making procedures safer for both patients and staff.

The national goal for time between patient arrival and opening of a blocked vessel is 90 minutes, putting Reading Hospital's Cath Lab 36 minutes below the national average—and saved time means saved lives.

The reduction in prep and procedure times also means more patients can be diagnosed and treated, stopping heart muscle damage, and alleviating pain quickly. The new Cath Lab is open 24/7 and can be fully operational within 20 minutes of a patient's arrival.

Other features of the new Cath Lab include:

- Exam and control room with x-ray and high-resolution LCD view of live and stored clinical images
- Carbon Fiber, radiolucent patient support with integrated system controls
- State-of-the-art real-time image processing based on latest parallel computing technology
- Noise and artifact reduction, image enhancement and real-time motion correction on live images
- One click procedure setup, including acquisition parameters and monitor viewing layout based on selection of procedure type

Expanding and Improving the Stop the Bleed Program

The American College of Surgeons' *Stop the Bleed* training started as a grassroots national awareness campaign and call-to-action encouraging bystanders to become trained, equipped, and empowered to help before the arrival of professionals on the scene of a bleeding emergency. Reading Hospital offers *Stop the Bleed* in-house training and training in community settings, such as area nonprofits, schools, urgent care and rehabilitation centers, and security departments. To make local outreach efforts more inclusive, The Friends of Reading Hospital provided funds to purchase community-specific materials and create an on-site skills lab teaching cart. *Stop the Bleed* training at Reading Hospital prepared New Castle Lawn and Landscape of Birdsboro, PA employees Zhane Stephenson and Devin Wiley to provide essential first-aid care and support to a critically injured car accident victim until professional help arrived.

MOTHER AND BABY



Reading Hospital Foundation Grants Support Maternal Health

Reading Hospital Foundation honors funding requests that support innovation, education, and research at Reading Hospital. The Foundation also responds to Reading Hospital employees' funding requests that enhance patient satisfaction, improve efficiency, or provide needed items.

Breast milk is the best milk for babies, and a quality breast pump can make all the difference for a busy new mom by facilitating breastfeeding support. Ten underserved moms received a high-quality Spectra S1 double electric pump, a purchase that also helps further the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services' "Healthy People 2030" goals, a set of national objectives for improving health and wellbeing over the next decade.

Seeing a need to support moms-in-waiting, a Reading Hospital employee started and funded a gift closet, presenting small weekly gifts to each antepartum inpatient to recognize her commitment to growing her baby another week closer to her due date. When the 44-year employee, named Pam, announced her retirement, her coworkers honored her by naming the gift closet "P.A.M.," meaning "Presents for Antepartum Moms." A grant from the Reading Hospital Foundation ensures that these special weekly gifts will continue. Grant Cibulsky, Quinn O'Donnell, and Adeline Cosentino of Wilson and Wyomissing High Schools are making a difference in the community by collecting much-needed items and donating them to antepartum mothers via PAM's Closet.

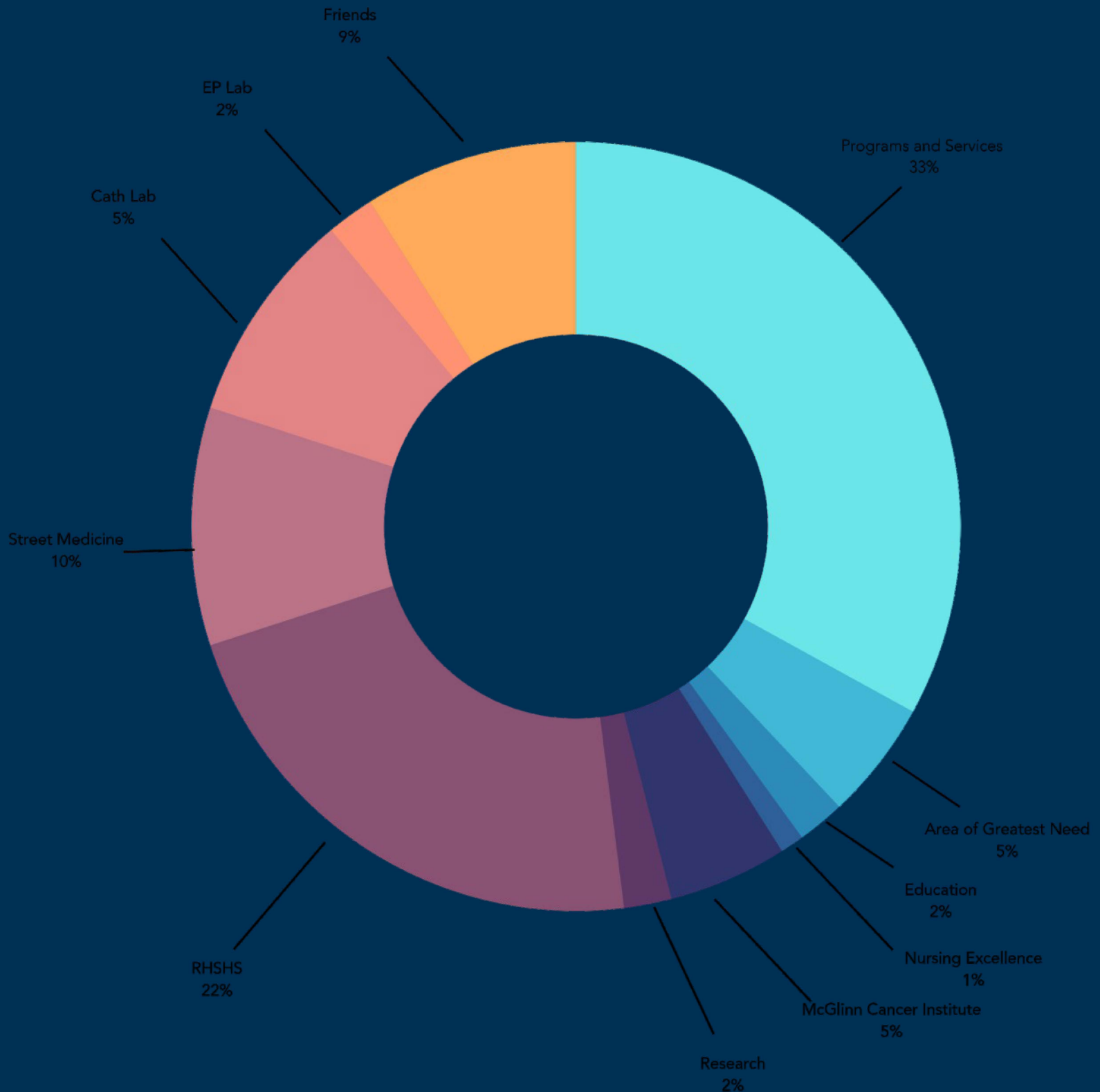
